Note: children are expected to be able to recall all multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12 by the end of Year 4.

Assessment: at the end of each weekly maths topic, children complete a short assessment to see which skills they have mastered. The end of term report score is calculated on an average of these mini-assessment scores.
